### Truth & Justice for Marcus Garvey After 83 Years

On August 17, 1887, Marcus Mosiah Garvey was born in St. Ann's Bay, Jamaica. He immigrated to the United States where he founded the UNIA-ACL – Universal Negro Improvement Association & African Communities League. The UNIA-ACL became the largest Black organization in history – dedicated to the economic, social, and political empowerment of African Americans, and the fostering of unity between all people of African descent. Marcus Garvey attracted millions of followers in Africa, the United States, Latin America, the Caribbean, and Europe. Marcus Garvey's efforts towards empowerment, and his message of unity, cultural pride, and self-sufficiency has rightfully earned him global recognition as a monumental figure in the U.S. and worldwide.

Future generations of all backgrounds will learn about this great leader without the anti-ethnic of a maliciously fabricated criminal record that was tainting the essence of his honorable work. Leading a movement for human rights and economic independence among Blacks, Marcus Garvey became the target of surveillance and harassment by the United States government law enforcement agencies. The case against Marcus Garvey was politically motivated, the charges unsubstantiated, and his conviction was unjust.

**Millions of petitioners have appealed for his exoneration...**

- **1925** – First official application for executive clemency.
- **1926** – Nine members of the jury that convicted Marcus Garvey signed an affidavit recommending the commutation of his sentence.
- **1964** – Marcus Garvey was declared Jamaica's first national hero.
- **On May 10, 2004** – the Hartford Connecticut City Court of Common Council PASSED a resolution calling for the exoneration of Marcus Garvey.
- **On February 14, 2005** – The City Council in Landerhill, Florida PASSED a resolution calling for the exoneration of Marcus Garvey.
- **On February 14, 2005** – sponsored by Charles Rangel from the House of Representatives, Congressional Resolution, GRANTED PARDON to dear Marcus Garvey's name and affirm his innocence of crimes for which he was unjustly prosecuted.
- **On February 14, 2005** – Was referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary's Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism and Homeland Security – where it remains today.
- **On December 19, 2005** – Gerry F. Miller, Chief Legislative Analyst for the Los Angeles Council Committee, recommended that the Los Angeles, California City Council adopt the exoneration resolution for Marcus Garvey.
- **On March 3, 2006** – Los Angeles City Council PASSED and supports the full and
